

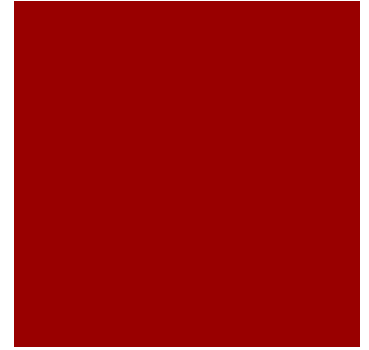

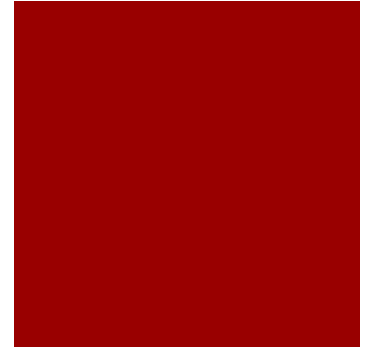

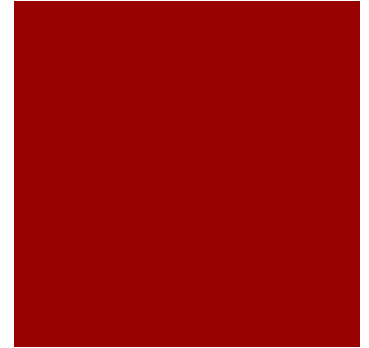
# Introduction

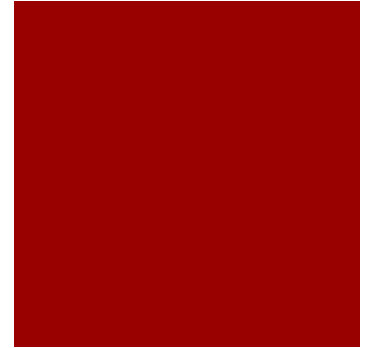


# Successes

- Department website with learning portal for post graduate learners

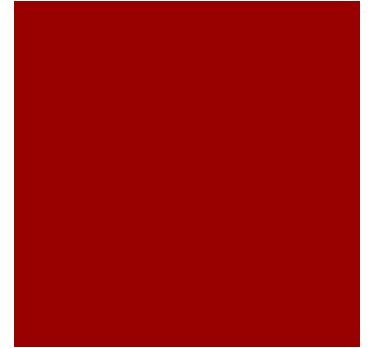

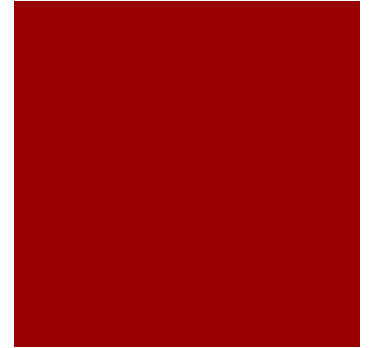
# Challenges

# Scholarly Activities

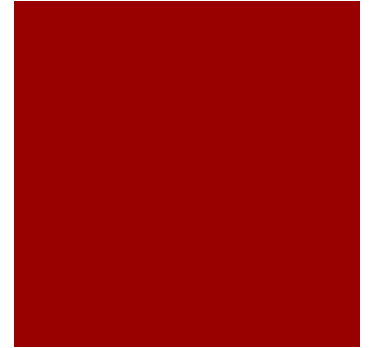
- NORACW

- Workshops-AIME course, EDE2





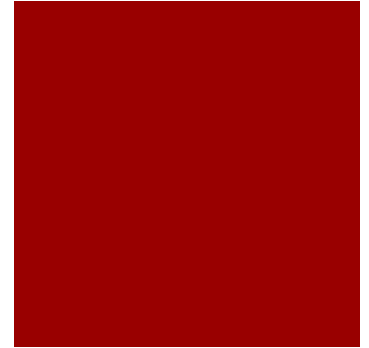
# Incentives
