

PCTA Member Eligibility

Every Group Physician who is a natural person, and every Designated Physician where the Group Physician is a Medicine Professional Corporation, shall:

- be a member of the Physician Organization;
- be a member of the College and hold a certificate of registration to practise medicine issued by the College under the Medicine Act;
- have malpractice protection through a commercial insurance program or membership in the CMPA or its equivalent; and
- have an academic appointment at NOSM.
