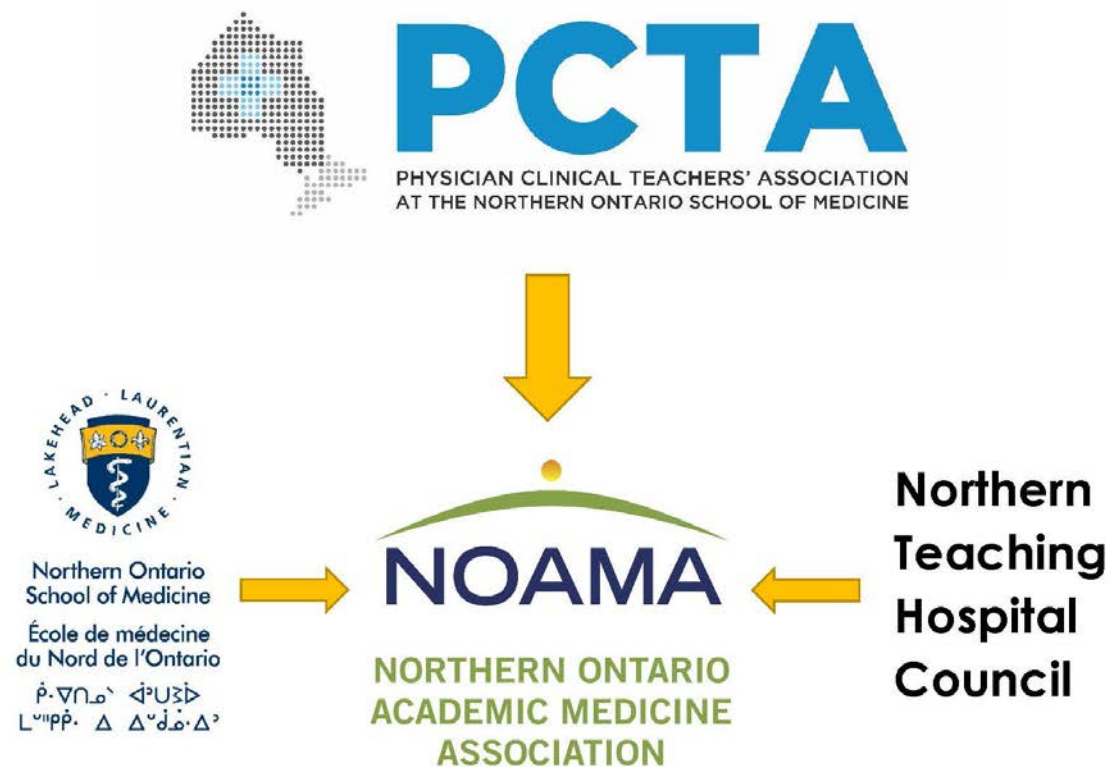

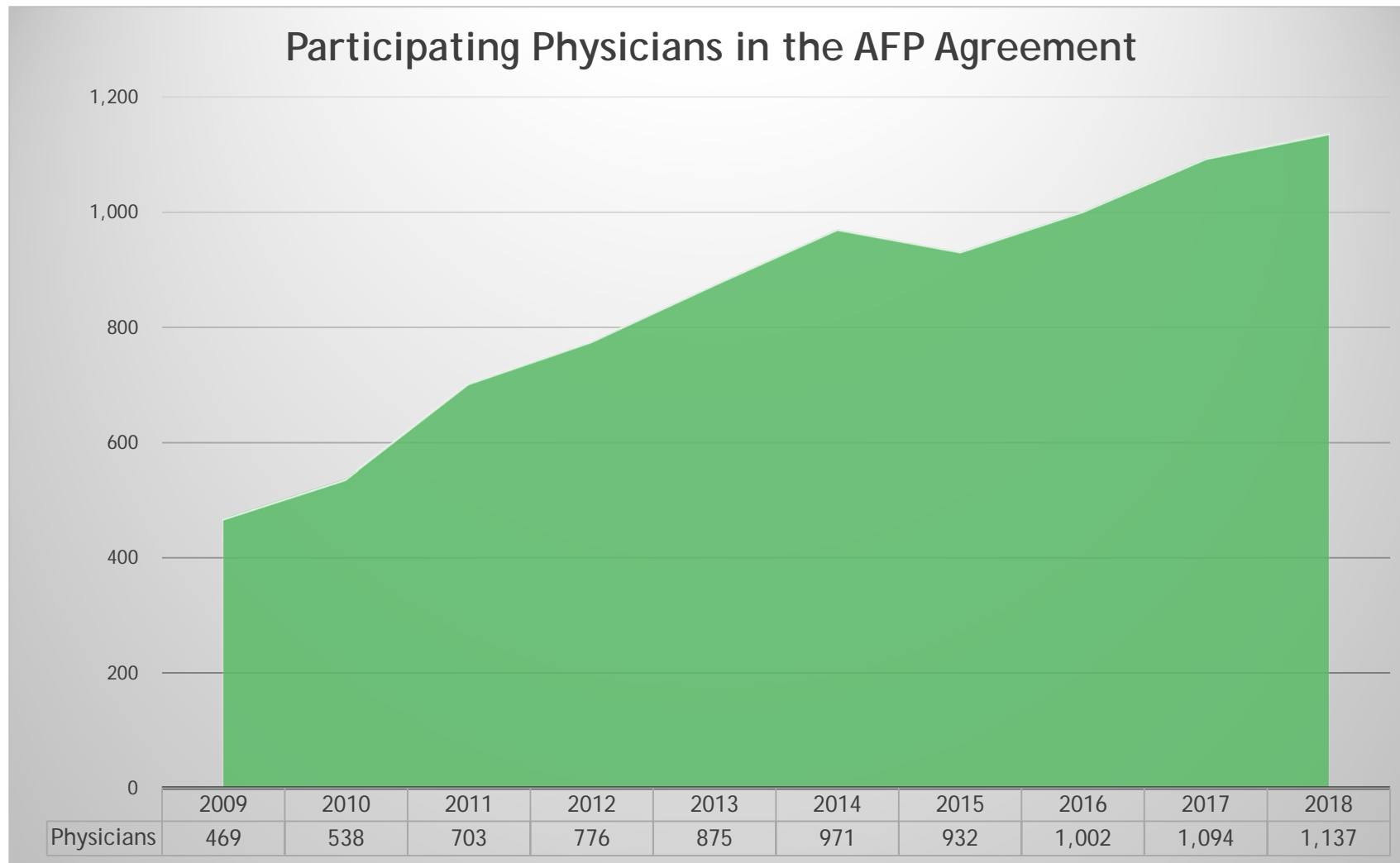


PCTA Member Eligibility

Every Group Physician who is a natural person, and every Designated Physician where the Group Physician is a Medicine Professional Corporation, shall:

- be a member of the Physician Organization;
- be a member of the College and hold a certificate of registration to practise medicine issued by the College under the *Medicine Act*;
- have malpractice protection through a commercial insurance program or membership in the CMPA or its equivalent; and
- have an academic appointment at NOSM.

3. Evaluate and monitor the balance between the LEG Funding Formula and Clinical Teaching Payments distributed to PCTA Members

TACTICS

1. Create the means to establish a virtual community of practise across the North to bolster collaboration;
2. Promote the annual LEG Lead & Administrator's meeting;
3. To promote the PCTA, ensure partnerships unite, and involve the PCTA with strategic moves encompassing clinical teaching, research, scholarly activity and innovation across Northern Ontario.

1. Continue to enhance shortfall of AFP Innovation funding received by allocating funding from the deferred revenue academic component;
2. Support the Clinical Innovation Opportunities Fund by dedicating a significant amount of the AFP funding to physician clinical faculty.

1. Maintain our partnerships with NOSM and NTHC as they have realized success in their funding models;
2. Cultivate new procedures (performance based) for funding to enhance accountability reporting;
3. Enhance reporting mechanisms (financial statements) to improve accountability.
