Summary of Changes

- 1. Retrospective payments
- 2. Single payment per rotation (no splitting)
- 3. 13 pay periods per year that align with PG Block Dates
- 4. Rotation pay period driven by rotation end date
- 5. Payment issued 4 weeks following the end of a pay period
- 6. No formal reconciliation process
- 7. Payment based on exact weeks



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Implementation Timelines

As Previously Presented

- Full Implementation
 - January 2018
 - Last period using
 Prepayment/Reconciliation was
 Oct-Dec 2017



Transition Plan

Prepayment/Reconciliation

- The last Prepayment & Reconciliation period was:
 - Oct 1 to Dec 31, 2017 (Q3)
 - Prepayment issued September 29, 2017
 - Reconciliation issued on March 9, 2018
- Contained any rotation ending on or before December 18, 2017



Transition Plan

New Process

- The first retrospective Block payment was:
 - 2017-18 Block 7 (Dec 19, 2017 to Jan 15, 2018)
 - Payment issued on Feb 9, 2018
 - Any rotation
- Contained any rotation ending on or after December 19, 2017



Pay Period Deliverables NOSM/NOAMA

For each pay period you can expect from us:

- 1. Summary and Details PDF to be sent in the week of the pay run by NOAMA
- 2. Payment to be received on the <u>Thursday</u>, 4 weeks after the Block end date
 - A pay advice will be generated by NOSM Finance on the day the payment is issued
- 3. Timely resolution to any issues/inquiries brought forward by LEGs



Pay Period Deliverables LEGs

For each pay period we are expecting from you:

- 1. Review of payments received
- Notify NOAMA of any discrepancies found between schedule and payment

 - Visiting electives
 - International Electives



New structure

- Single point of contact
 - Learner & Community
 - All rotations (Electives and Core)
 - Housing
 - Integration of Health Sciences

 - NOSM UG & PG Electives
 - Visiting Canadian Electives
