The Northern Ontario Academic Medicine Association (NOAMA) is the governance organization responsible for administering the Ministry of Health and OMA negotiated NOAMA Academic Funding Plan (AFP).

The AFP Innovation Fund provides funding to support the development of new and innovative approaches to health care delivery and to provide leadership in the dissemination of new knowledge across the healthcare system.

Physicians in Northern Ontario have the opportunity to access these funds to support their research or investigation of new and creative methodologies for health care delivery, and knowledge dissemination.

#### Grant Information:

- \*\*NEW\*\* Funding requests are per annum of \$30k/year for up to 2 years
- \*\*NEW\*\* One grant at \$60k/annum (\$120k over two years) will be awarded in the "Mid-Scale Grant Category."

- Grants must be compliant with AFP Grant Application Checklist
- P1 must be submitted in fillable PDF form we copy information from the form to IFPOC for funding approval
