Background Information:

The Northern Ontario Academic Medicine Association (NOAMA) is the governance organization responsible for administering the Ministry of Health and OMA negotiated NOAMA Academic Funding Plan (AFP). The AFP Innovation Fund provides funding to support the development of new and innovative approaches to healthcare delivery and to provide leadership in the dissemination of new knowledge across the healthcare system. Physicians in Northern Ontario have the opportunity to access these funds to support their research or investigation of new and creative methodologies for health care delivery, and knowledge dissemination.

- ***Reminder of important changes***
 - PIs who received AFP funding in the previous year are ineligible to apply as PIs in the current cycle, though they may participate in other roles.
 - 40% of AFP funding will be reserved for first-time applicants who haven't received a NOAMA grant in the past five years.
- The Transfer Payment Agency managing your project funds will be required to sign off on our new agreement letter. The new form is available on the website.
- Funding requests are per annum of \$30k/year (\$60k over two years) will be awarded
- One Mid-Scale grant at \$60k/annum (\$120k over two years) may be awarded
- Grants must be compliant with AFP Grant Application Checklist
