Keys to Success & Lessons Learned

- Identify 1 goal for the session
- Obtain support from Nursing Clinical Lead*
- Set the stage for the sim (Pre-Brief)
 - "sim is a safe space", tour the sim bay, go over logistics,
 - please suspend disbelief this can be a good learning tool
 - if you don't know something ask us ... we'll tell you
 - please go through the motions as you would in a real situation
 - for monitors and IV lines, please put them on and tape them in place
 - designate roles (i.e. team leader, nurse, RT, medical student)
- Follow the department's current procedure and if changes are needed post sim ensure they are actually made. Seeing change encourages continued participation.
- Allow sufficient time for the debrief. Close the session reminding participants that sim is a safe space and try to leave on a positive note.

Start Up Costs

- Average mannequin costs
 - Sim Man: \$10,0000
 - Sim Child: \$2500-\$3000
 - Sim Baby & Sim Pelvis: \$2500-\$3000
- Being a low fidelity setup, we have chosen to use 2 iPads and the SimMon app which is currently \$25.99
- The Huntsville Physician and South Muskoka LEGs compensate the physicians who facilitate the sessions
