  - Scholarship, Research, and Innovation
  - Professional Development: CME and/or Faculty Development

# LEG Funding Formula

## LEG Income Distribution:

- Funding received from NOAMA
- Dependent on Governance Agreement
  - Section outlining method for fund distribution
- No involvement from NOAMA/NOSM



# LEG Funding Formula

LEG Allocation	LEG "A" (10 Members)	LEG "B" (25 Members)	LEG "C" (100 Members)
Leadership/Faculty Development	$10/1,000 \times 900,000 =$ \$9,000	$25/1,000 \times 900,000 =$ \$22,500	$100/1,000 \times 900,000 =$ \$90,000
Enhanced Research & Scholarly Activities Development	$10/1,000 \times 1,030,000 =$ *\$15,000 * <u>minimum</u> amount applied	$25/1,000 \times 1,030,000 =$ \$25,750	$100/1,000 \times 1,030,000 =$ *\$100,000 * <u>maximum</u> amount applied
* Clinical Teaching Academic (includes administration component for clinical teaching)	200 weeks x 375 = \$75,000	200 weeks x 375 = \$75,000	200 weeks x 375 = \$75,000
Annual LEG Funding Allocation	AFP (NOAMA) \$99,000 NOSM Clinical Teaching \$50,000	AFP (NOAMA) \$123,250 NOSM Clinical Teaching \$50,000	AFP (NOAMA) \$265,000 NOSM Clinical Teaching \$50,000

# LEG Funding Formula

## **Group (Eligible) Physician must:**

1. be a member of the College and hold a certificate of registration to practise medicine issued by the College under the *Medicine Act*;
2. have an academic appointment at NOSM; and
3. have a signed Declaration and Consent (D&C) with NOAMA

# LEG Membership - Eligibility

## LEG Membership:

- Do not need to be an eligible physician
  - Only eligible physicians receive funding
- Confirmed annually by NOAMA
  - Changes throughout year need to be communicated from the LEG
- Member of multiple LEGs



# LEG Membership - Eligibility

- LEG Member joining multiple LEGs need to fill a “LEG Membership Change Form”




# NOAMA Grants

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Projects that support the development of new and innovative approaches to health care delivery and to provide leadership in the dissemination of new knowledge across the healthcare system.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Projects that support the development and implementation of new evidence-based enhancements within their clinical practices resulting in a change in practice to facilitate “better care.”</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>81 projects approved allocating \$4.83 million in funding</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>135 projects approved allocating \$6.28 million in funding</li> </ul>
