Practice Based Research Networks

- What is a PBRN?
- Canadian Primary Care Sentinel Surveillance Network (CPCSSN) established in 2005
 - Funded initially by Public Health Agency of Canada (PHAC)
 - HTN, OA, DM, COPD, depression
 - Alzheimer's, epilepsy, Parkinson's





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- Collect patient health data from Northern Ontario community-based practices
- Use data to answer practice-based research questions
